

Report of Training Activities Under NRHM / RCH – II for the quarter ending March 31st, 2008

Activities under NRHM / RCH – II

National Institute of Health & Family Welfare (NIHFW), has been identified as Nodal Institute with support of 18 Collaborating training Institutes (CTIs) for training under NRHM and RCH – II. NIHFW has pursued responsibilities of organizing National Level Training Courses and coordination the NRHM / RCH training activities with the help of Collaborating Training Institutions (CTIs) in various parts of the country. The list of activities being undertaken in this regard is given below:

1. I. Training Courses and other related activities at National Level

a.) PMU

- Two orientation Training Courses for State Programme & PMU officials were conducted from (i) 21st -25th Jan.'08 (vi) 4th -8th Feb.'08 at NIHFW, New Delhi. 64 persons were trained.

b.) Integrated Training on NRHM

- A Training Courses for “Integrated Service Delivery under NRHM” was conducted from 7th – 12th Jan.'08 at NIHFW New Delhi. 39 Persons were trained.

c) Alternative Training Methodology in IUCD

- Re- Orientation Training of Master Trainers on Alternative Training Methodology in IUCD was held on 25th – 26th Feb.'08 at NIHFW, New Delhi. 27 persons were from states of Assam, Chhattisgarh, Delhi, Gujarat, Jharkahand, Kerala, Karnataka, Maharashtra, MP, Rajasthan, UP & West Bengal attended the Re-Orientation Programme.

II. Training of Trainers (TOT) Conducted at State Level

- a.) SBA:** - During the quarter (Jan. –March), 569 persons were trained under Training of Trainers (TOT) courses in various states.
- b.) PMU:** - During the quarter (Jan. –March.), 66 persons were trained under DPMU Training.

III. Training at District Level

a.) Specialized Clinical Skill Training

Specialized Skill Training of MOs in Minilap sterilization and MTP as well as a team of Gynecologist/Surgeons, Staff Nurse and OT Technician for Laparoscopic sterilization and ANM for IUCD insertion is continuing in all the states. The objective is to ensure that there is adequate number of trained manpower to provide good quality of services for prevention and management of unwanted pregnancy. During the quarter, 857 persons have been trained in various specialized clinical skill training programmes.

b.) SBA Training

The objective of SBA training is to upgrade skills of ANM/LHV/Staff Nurses posted in district hospital /CHC / PHC to improve quality of intra-partum and New born care in institution and achieve better maternal and infant salvage. During the quarter (Jan. –March), 759 persons were trained in SBA and total of 3483 persons were trained upto 31.03.08.

c.) Integrated Skill Development Training(IST) for Health Personnel

Conduction of IST for different categories of service providers including MO(PHC), ANM, LHV, HW(M), HA(M) and Staff Nurse under RCH Programme is continuing at district level in various States and UTs. During the quarter, a total of 488 ANMs, 115 LHVs, 307 MOs, 87 HWs(M), 145 HS(M) and 262 Staff Nurses were trained.

2. NPCC / JRM Meetings:-

Director NIHFW is a member of NPCC & NPCC Sub Committee which reviews all PIPs. As such RCH Consultants of NIHFW were given the responsibility to review all State/UT PIPs & give suggestions for improvement, especially if the training component in the PIP to make training more effective in improving the technical quality of service delivery. The recommendation of NIHFW were sent to the DC Training & Nodal Officer for each state. Consultants & Faculty of NIHFW attended the JRM meeting & PIP meeting both NPCC & Sub Committee and interacted with states to give their recommendation.

- Dr. S. Menon, ANO & Dr. Bindoo Sharma, Consultant attended Joint Review Mission Meeting regarding training of RCH-II Programme on 12th Feb. 2008 held at MOHFW, New Delhi.
- NO/ANO and various consultants attended Joint Review Mission meetings RCH–II Programme held at MOHFW from 11th – 20th Feb. 2008.
- NO/ANO, Faculty and various consultants attended Sub Group & NPCC Meetings held from 25th Feb. – 28th March 2008 at MOHFW for state PIPs under NRHM for the

year 2008-09. NIHFV submitted comments and suggestions for improvement of training on all state PIPs.

5. Monitoring Visit Under NRHM / RCH for Monitoring Programme Performance

- Dr. Bindoo Sharma , Consultant (Medical) & Dr. Pritha Sahgal ,Consultant (Medical) visited Haldwani (Uttarakhand) from 21st – 24th Jan. 2008 for (i) Contraceptive update workshop (ii) RCH / NRHM Orientation workshop (iii) Monitoring of RCH services at sub DH of Haldwani & (iv) Monitoring of RCH services for 24x7 PHCs at Motu Haldu.
- Dr. Pritha Sehgal, Mr. Madhav and Dr. H. Meiti visited Lucknow & Unnao Districts of UP State from 31st March to 2nd April 2008 for monitoring of health facilities under RCH.
- Dr. Bindoo Sharma, Mr. Aditya Bhargva & Dr. A.M. Khan visited Bhopal & Sehore Districts of MP from 31st to 2nd April 2008 for monitoring of health facilities under RCH.

Feed back on Monitoring visits and suggestion to take corrective action given to concerned state / district / CTI officials to improve quality of training e.g. need to providing adequate opportunity for practicing necessary skills, maintenance of daily diary by each trainees, to issue proficiency and attendance certificates to trainees.

6. Professional Development Course (PDC):-

- The Professional Development Course for Management, Public Health & Health Sector Reforms for District Level Medical Officers funded by MOHFW was started with the objective of training middle level medical officers with 12-16 years of services, to be able to function effectively for service delivery. This integrated training incorporates management, public health and ongoing reforms in the country including the NRHM in a ten weeks programme.
- This course is now a component of IPHS norms for Medical Officer at District Level in NRHM. Supervision and monitoring has been done regularly by faculty from NIHFWS namely Professor Madhulekha Bhattacharya, Dr. A. M. Khan, Dr. U. Datta, Dr. V. K. Tiwari and Dr. Rajni Bagga besides by Dr. P. C. Samantaray, Consultant for this course. The course was started by NIHFWS (Nodal Institute) in 2001 and has been rolled out in 2005 with 11 CTIs participating in conduction of the course.
- During the quarter a total of 124 and a total of 1003 officers have been trained from various states.
